Concrete examples of Accor Group's environmental commitment

Since 2022, Accor has been the first global hotel group to commit to phasing out single-use plastics in the guest experience. By 2025, this commitment became a reality: over 95% of our hotels are now free of single-use plastics in rooms, bathrooms, and common areas. This achievement is the result of collective efforts with our teams, partners, and suppliers.

Moreover, since 2022, Accor has implemented an ambitious energy-saving plan, still in effect in 2025, based on four major actions:

- Temperature regulation in rooms and common areas according to the season and national recommendations (heating capped at 19°C, air conditioning at 26°C);-
- Reducing and recycling waste
- Seasonal or partial closure of outdoor pools and reduced access hours to relaxation areas (saunas, steam rooms);
- Removal of over 50,000 minibars in rooms, replaced by shared refreshment areas;
- Energy optimization in kitchens, with strict consumption control and an active food waste reduction policy.

These initiatives are part of our broader ecological transition strategy and contribute daily to reducing the environmental impact of our sector.

Our daily environmental commitments

Trained and committed teams

- Our environmental officer is trained in sustainable tourism and CSR issues
- All our staff apply eco-friendly practices daily
- We select our service providers based on social and environmental criteria
- We promote eco-friendly transportation: bikes, shuttles, public transport, carpooling

Water and energy savings

- Flow restrictors installed on all taps and showers
- Monthly monitoring of water and electricity consumption
- Gradual replacement of lighting with LED bulbs (already over 75% installed)
- Use of green energy through a renewable electricity provider

Waste reduction and sorting

- Recycling bins available in all areas, with pre-collection bags for rent
- Organic waste sorted for use in biogas production
- Preference for bulk and large packaging to reduce waste
- Clear signage to help with in-room recycling
- Use of a smart bin to measure and better manage our waste

Sustainable dining

- Dishes made with local and seasonal products
- Vegetarian options and menus adapted to specific diets
- Organic and/or fair trade products offered
